They have since grown to a huge factory where we make beautiful world class Jewelry from clay and provide employment to over 300 single mothers in Kenya.





## KAREN BLIXEN MUSEUM

The Karen Blixen Museum not only provides the most comprehensive insight into the persona of Karen Blixen, but also offers a fantastic space for personal reflection in the nature trail, against a back drop of Karen's beloved Ngong Hills. The location of the movie 'Out of Africa', an Oscar winning film based on Karen's autobiography by the same title.

## NAIROBI NATIONAL PARK

Established in December 1946, Nairobi National Park is Kenya's oldest National Park. The park is a leading sanctuary to the Black Rhinos, unique to Kenya. This is one of the parks in Kenya where one is also likely to see a pride of lions resting in the middle of the road. The park also contains the historic Ivory Burning site.



## SHELDRIK WILDLIFE TRUST

Best known for their work to protect the elephants, the Sheldrick Wildlife Trust operates the most successful orphan elephant rescue and rehabilitation program.

## NGONG HILLS

## **MAT BRONZE RESTAURANT**

Matbronze was founded in 1987, by Kenyan artist, Denis Mathews. It was the first bronze foundry in Kenya, and has expanded into a gallery, restaurant and local attraction.

## **TIN ROOF CAFE**

Located in the heart of Langata at the Langata Link shops and in the heart of Karen, it is an ideal meet up point with friends and family on an outdoor terrace.

## **BROWN'S CHEESE FARM**

Brown's Food Co. began in 1979 when delicious cheese was made at a kitchen table for a family to enjoy. Fast forward to today, and you will find that Brown's are still very much a family-run business, and everything they produce is dreamt up, developed and taste-tested.

## **TALISMAN RESTAURANT**

From the humble beginnings back in the 90's, The Talisman started as a small old house in Karen originally occupied by the famous wildlife photographer and author Alan Root in their youth. The Talisman has since grown into a household name with one of the best cuisines in the country.







### **GATURA GREENS TEA FARM**

The Purple Tea Farm Tour Gatura Greens is home to the first purple tea farm in Kenya and is now open to guests to experience an authentic tea farm tour including a tea tasting of over 10 different types of teas made at the cottage Factory. They also have a beautiful waterfall trek through a bamboo forest.

### **FAIRVIEW ESTATE COFFEE TOUR**
